



ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES OVERVIEW

Below is an overview of the typical design process for an architectural project.

1 DREAMING

This first part of the process is when Leana and the client meet together to think big and lay out the overall vision for the project. It's a critical step because it begins the process of communication and sets the path for the entire project. We do our best to think through every aspect of the project and from there develop clear priorities.

2 DESIGNING

Once these initial discussions have taken place, Leana will begin to put the ideas on paper. Typically, this process begins as a series of sketches and evolves into a computer-generated 3D model. With each iteration, Leana and the client will collaborate to refine the design into one that most beautifully connects the vision, aesthetic, and budget.

3 DEVELOPING

As the design becomes more established, Leana will begin to develop a preliminary set of floor plans, elevations, and sections. These are not yet the final drawings, but they begin to reconcile the design with the realistic nuts and bolts of construction. Over the course of this process, the design becomes finalized.

4 PRODUCING

The final step is to prepare the design for construction and permitting. Leana will produce a set of construction documents which is a detailed set of drawings. It includes a site plan, floor plans, elevations, sections, construction details, and anything else that is necessary to construct the project. Once the construction documents are completed, they are submitted to the City for permitting.

Leana is a knowledgeable, thorough, and intuitive designer. Perhaps more importantly, however, is her ability to communicate clearly and ask good questions. She believes that communication is the most critical aspect of working with a client on any design project, and strives to make clear and consistent communication a big part of her process.
